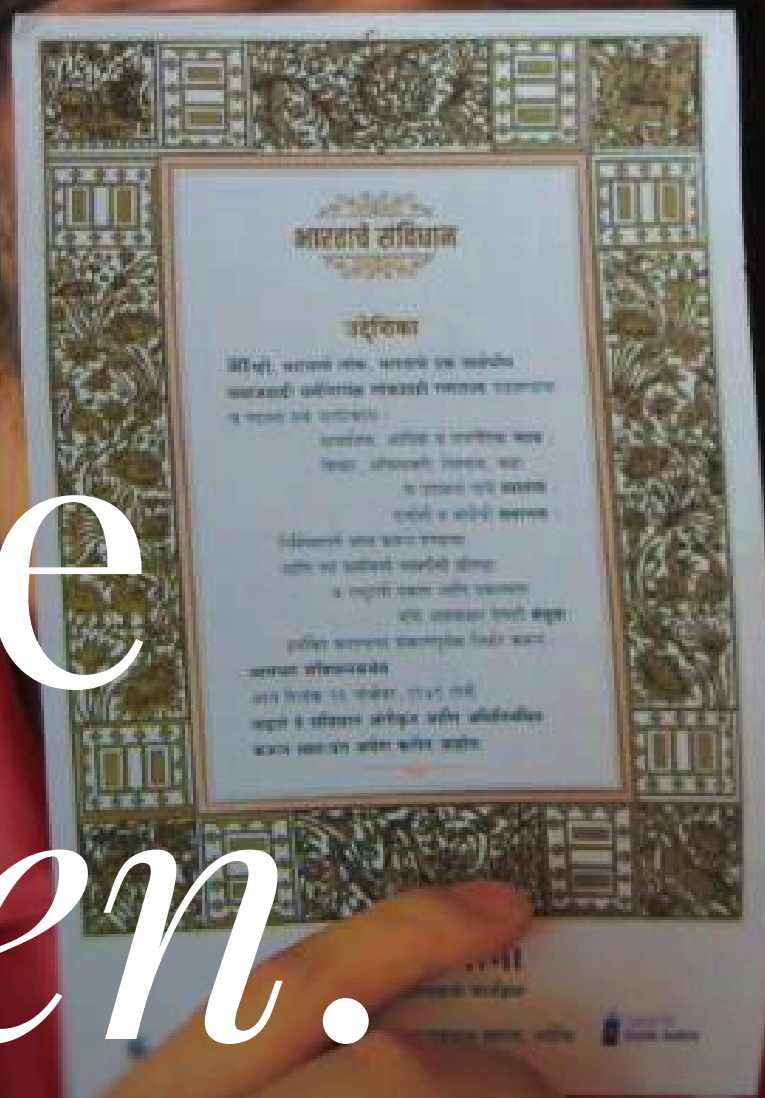

The programme prepares the candidates to become effective change makers by directly engaging with and learning from stakeholders at the grassroots, with **10 days of field travel each month.**

Our YPs build a holistic and multidisciplinary understanding of change-making by intimately engaging with field realities, strong mentorship by leaders and an environment of care and love.

New environments and new realities push YPs to grow personally and professionally, often challenging them to push themselves to learn about the law at grassroots, different cultures, teamwork, love, and most importantly themselves.
