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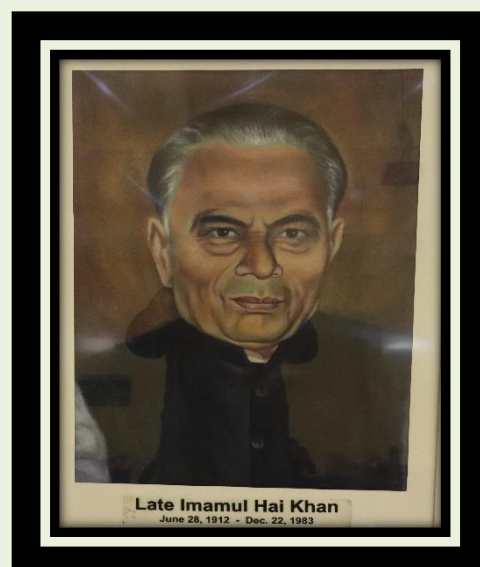
1. ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

- **Preliminary Rounds & Quarter-Finals:** This shall take place in the Hybrid Mode where the Teams shall mark their presence online and argue the matter from the both sides.

- **Semi-Finals & Final Round:** This shall take place in Physical Mode at the Campus of Imamul Hai Khan Law College, Bokaro Steel City, Jharkhand.

7. ELIGIBILITY & TEAM COMPOSITION

- **Eligibility:** The Competition is open to all Bonafide students currently pursuing the 3-year LL.B. course or the 5-year integrated B.A. LL.B. / B.B.A. LL.B. / B.Com. LL.B. / B.Sc. LL.B. course from any college/university recognized by the BCI and/or UGC in India.
- **Team Composition:** Each Team shall mandatorily consist of **three (3) members:** Two (2) Speakers and One (1) Researcher.
- **Participation Limit:** A maximum of **Two (2) Teams** from a single institution are permitted. Preferably One (1) Team from 5 Years and Other from 3 Years Course.
- **Cap:** Registration is strictly on a first-come, first-served basis, capped at a maximum of **24 Teams**.

8. REGISTRATION DETAILS

- **Registration Fee:** ₹2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) per Team.
- **Mode of Registration:** Registration shall be effected exclusively through the Official Google Form provided via the link. Every Participating Team must fill this form.
- **Mandatory Documents:**
 - Bona Fide Certificate / ID Card duly signed by the parent institution.
 - Recent passport-size photographs of participants.
 - Authorisation letter from the Head of Institution.

9. COMPETITION STRUCTURE

Day 1: 12th September 2026, Saturday

- **Preliminary Rounds:** Every team will participate in two rounds—once arguing for the Petitioner and once for the Respondent. Teams will have 15 minutes to present. Rebuttals are not permitted.

Day 2: 13th September 2026, Sunday

- **Quarter-Final Round (Knockout):** The top 8 teams based on cumulative scores (oral + memorial) advance. Teams will have 20 minutes (inclusive of up to 3 minutes of rebuttal).

Day 3: 20th September 2026, Sunday

- **Semi-Final Round:** The top 4 teams compete in a knockout format. Teams have 30 minutes inclusive of 5 minutes of rebuttal. Memorial scores are *not* considered here.
- **Final Round:** The winning two teams face off before an esteemed bench. Teams have 30 minutes inclusive of rebuttals. For Further Details, Refer the Rules and Regulations in the Link above.

10. MEMORIAL GUIDELINES

- Each team must submit **two (2) memorials** (Petitioner & Respondent).
- **Format:** Soft copies must be submitted in both .docx and .pdf formats.
- **Hardcopies:** All Participants must submit their Memorial Hardcopies by 7th September 2026.
- **Font:** Times New Roman, Size 12 for body (1.5 spacing), Size 10 for footnotes (single spacing).
- **Page Limit:** Maximum 30 pages (excluding Annexures).
- **Citation Style:** 21st Edition of The Bluebook.
- **Colour Coding:** BLUE for Petitioner/Appellant; RED for Respondent.
- **Strict Prohibitions:** * **Anonymity:** No institutional identifiers should appear on the memorial.
 - **Plagiarism:** Limit is 20%. Deduction of 2 marks for every percentage point above this.
 - **AI Tools:** The use of generative AI tools (Chat GPT, Claude, etc.) is strictly

prohibited and will result in immediate disqualification.

11. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Memorial Evaluation (100 Marks):

- It will Test the Participants on Knowledge of Law and Facts (20); Ingenuity and Ability to Answer Questions (20); Style, Poise, Courtesy and Demeanour (20); Organisation and Flow of Arguments (20); Proper Citation, Footnoting and References (20).

Oral Round Evaluation (100 Marks per Speaker):

- It will Test the Participants on Knowledge of Law and Facts (20); Application of Law to Facts and Use of Authorities (20); Ingenuity and Ability to Answer Questions from the Bench (20); Court-craft, Style, Poise and Demeanour (20); Articulation, Organisation and Flow of Arguments (20).

12. AWARDS & PRIZES

- **Winning Team:** ₹ 10,000/- + Winner's Trophy + Certificate of Merit
- **Runner-Up Team:** ₹ 5,000/- + Runner-Up's Trophy + Certificate of Merit
- **Best Speaker:** ₹ 3,000/- + Trophy + Certificate of Merit
- **Best Memorial:** ₹ 3,000/- + Trophy + Certificate of Merit
- **All Participants:** Certificate of Participation
