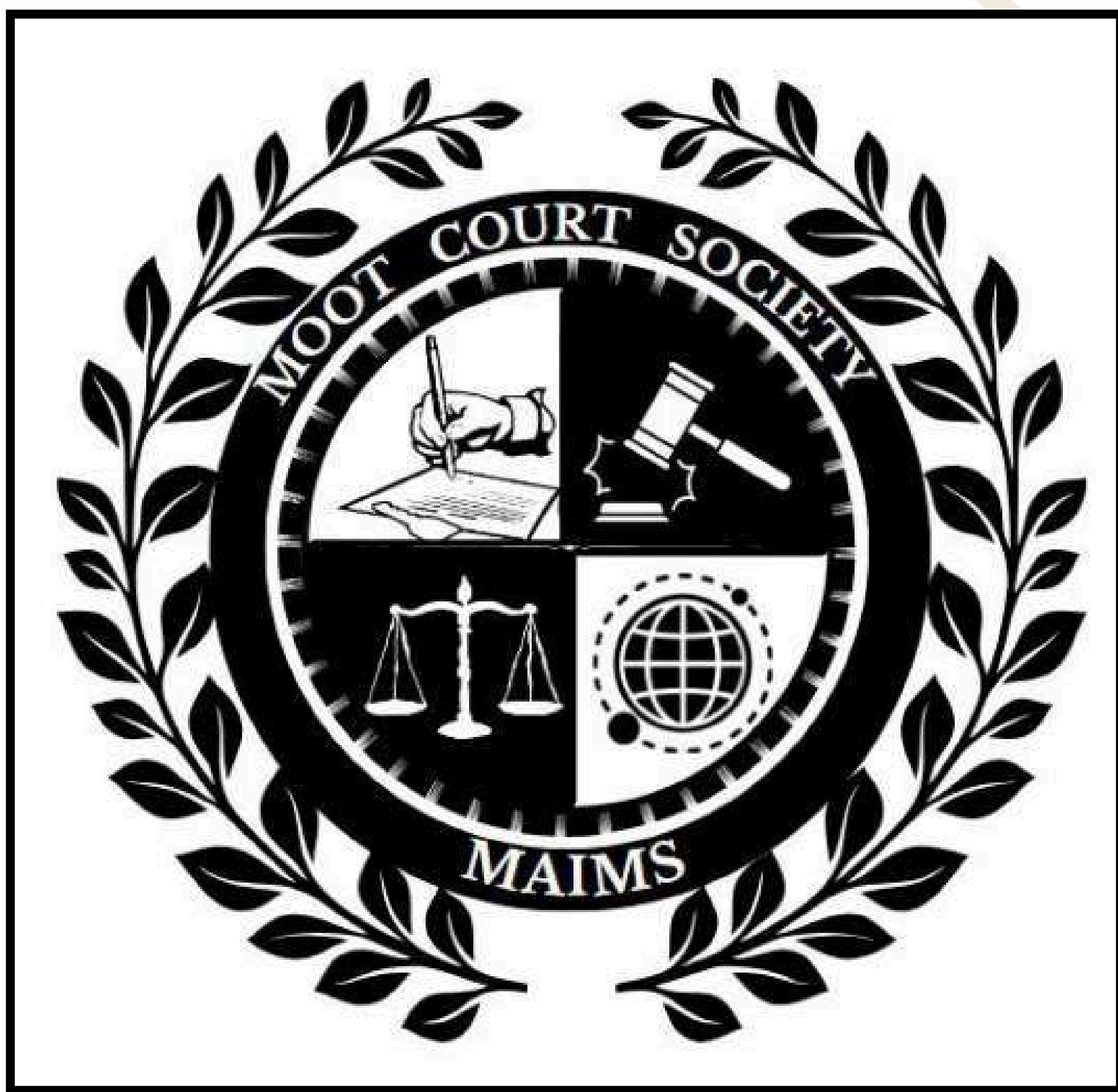

ABOUT MAIMS 7th NATIONAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION, 2026

The MAIMS 7th National Moot Court Competition, 2026, aims to provide a platform for law students across India to showcase their advocacy, legal research, and analytical skills in a professional and intellectually stimulating environment. The competition is organized with the objective of nurturing and strengthening participants' core advocacy skills while promoting excellence in legal education. The Department of Law, has consistently fostered a strong mooting culture through its Moot Court Society by regularly conducting advocacy training sessions, workshops, seminars, and interactive learning programmes to equip students with essential skills in legal research, drafting, oral advocacy, and courtroom etiquettes.

Since its inception, the Department has organised Extempore Moot Court and Intra Moot Court Competitions, with its National Moot Court Competition emerging as its flagship annual event. Since its launch in 2020, the competition has successfully completed six editions, attracting participation from leading law institutions across the country and establishing itself as a prestigious platform for advocacy and legal excellence. In recent years, the Moot Court Society has also introduced the Hindi Moot Court Competition, which has received an overwhelming response from participants.

The Inaugural Ceremony of the MAIMS 7th National Moot Court Competition, 2026 will be organised on 30th October, 2026 followed by the Preliminary Rounds on 31st October, 2026 in online mode. The qualifying teams shall be competing for offline oral rounds in the premises of Maharaja Agrasen Institute of Management Studies, Rohini, Delhi on 20th & 21st November, 2026.



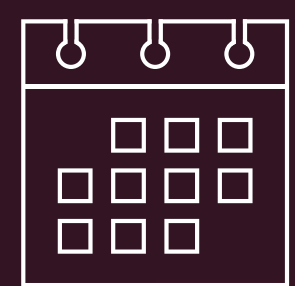
COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- All the students who are pursuing a full-time three-year [LL.B.] programme or five-year (integrated) [LL.B. (Hons.)] programme from any institution/university recognised by the Bar Council of India or any other equivalent competent authority shall be eligible to participate in the Competition.
- Each team shall consist of three members. This number cannot be modified under any circumstances.
- In a team consisting of three members, two members shall be designated as 'Speakers', and the third member shall be designated as 'Researcher'.
- All the participating teams must confirm participation by filling out a Registration Form on or before 11:59 PM IST, 10th SEPTEMBER, 2026 .
- As per the rules, each team, upon completion of registration, shall be allotted a unique Team Code for the competition. Each team must use the Team Code for further communication with the organising committee during the course of the competition.
- Any change must be intimated to the organising committee at the earliest through an e-mail at mootcourtsociety@mains.ac.in. Such a change must be accompanied by a fresh filled registration form.
- Post registration, participants will receive an email, signifying the acceptance of their request for participation, latest by 15th SEPTEMBER 2026.
- The participating teams are required to pay INR 5,000/- as the registration fees for the competition.
- However, an Early Bird registration fee of INR 4,500/- is available for participants who register on or before 20th AUGUST, 2026.
- Teams qualifying for the quarter-final round shall bear their own additional charges of INR 3,500 /- (optional) for accomodation.

ONLY THE PRELIMINARY ROUNDS I & II SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ONLINE MODE. QUARTER-FINALS, SEMI-FINALS, AND THE FINAL ROUND SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN OFFLINE MODE.

STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION

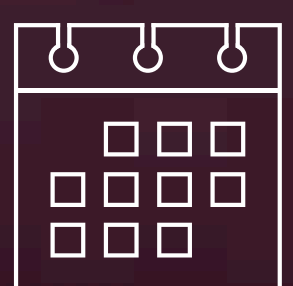
The Competition shall consist of four rounds:

PRELIMINARY ROUNDS (I & II):

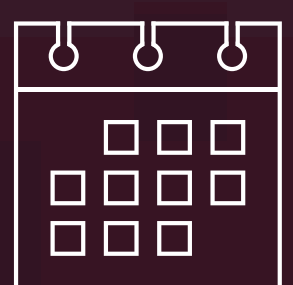
The Preliminary Rounds shall be held on 31st October, 2026 in Online Mode. All the teams shall be competing twice in the Preliminary Rounds. After competing, the best 8 teams will advance to the Quarter-Final Round.



**20th November,

QUARTER FINAL ROUND:

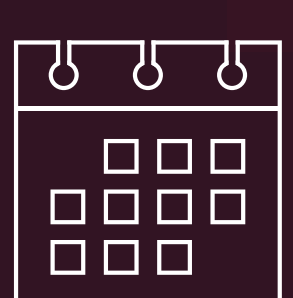
The best eight teams shall qualify for the Quarter-Final Round, which will be held on 20th November, 2026 in Offline Mode. After competing, the top 4 teams (on knockout basis) will advance to the Semi-Final Round.

SEMI-FINAL ROUND:

The best four teams (on knockout basis) shall qualify for the Semi-Final Round, which will be held on 20th November, 2026 in Offline Mode. After competing, the top 2 teams will advance to the Final Round.

The Final Round shall be held on 21st November, 2026 in Offline Mode. After competing, the team with the highest score will be announced as the Winner of the Competition.

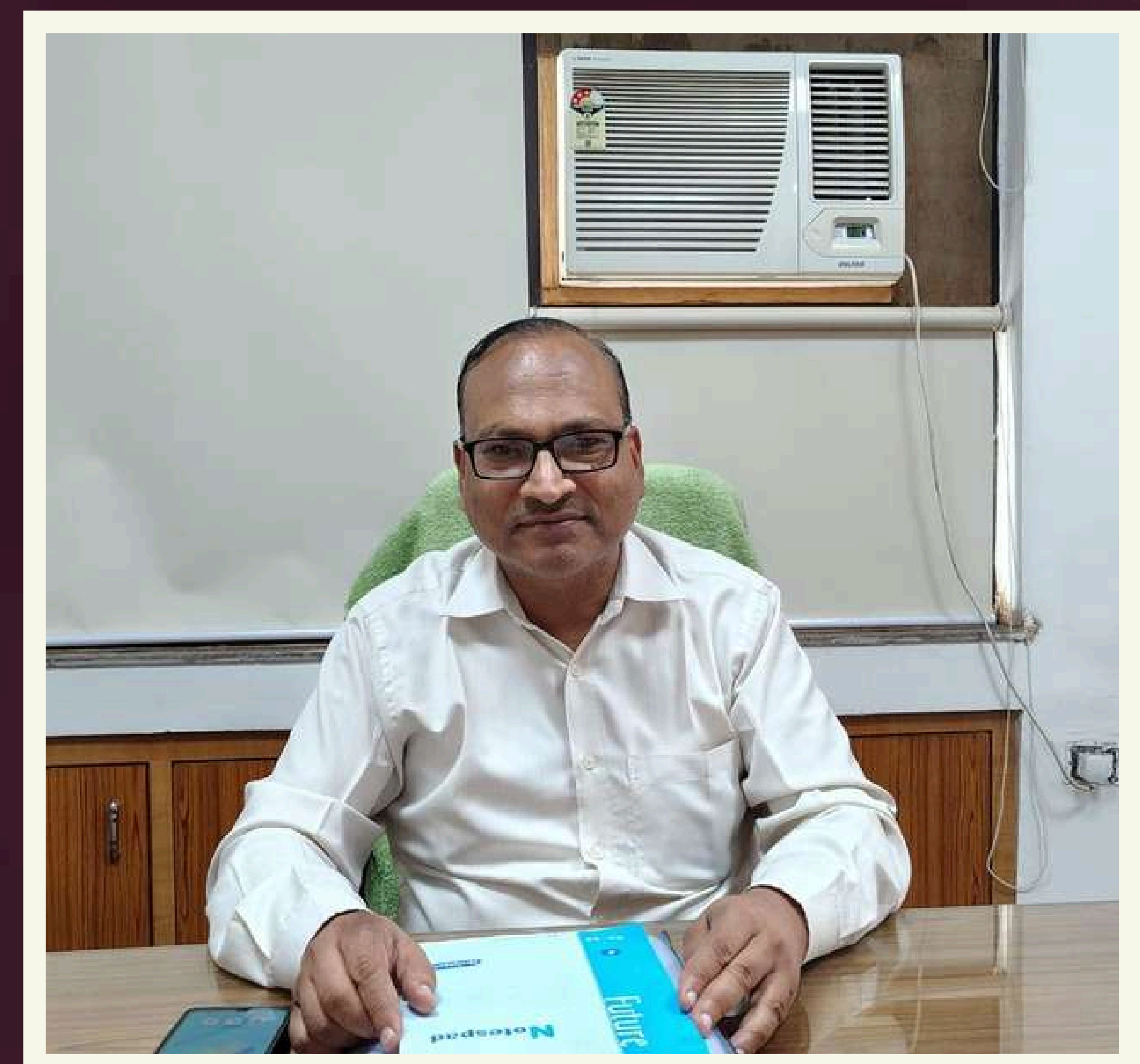

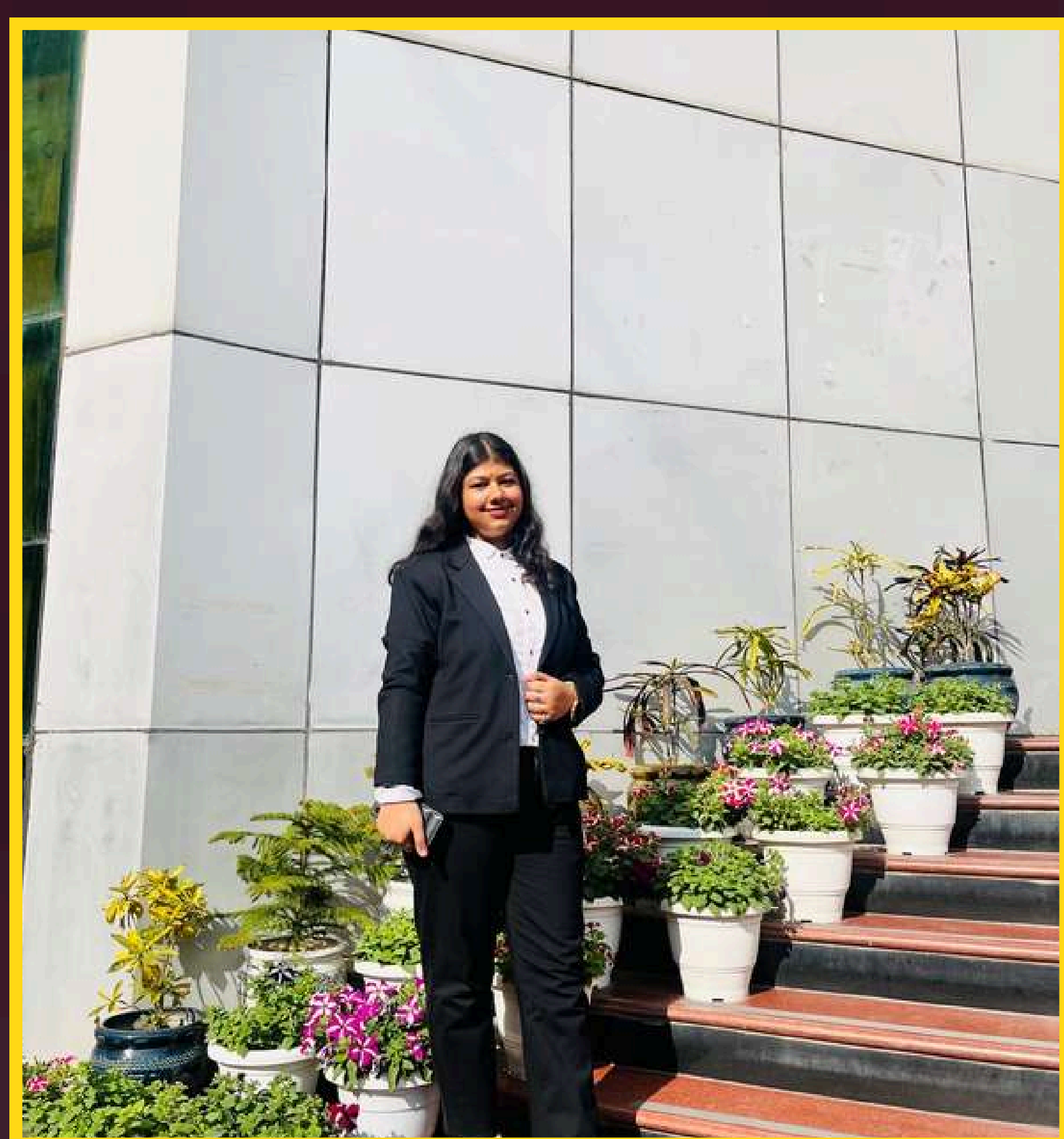
