GUIDELINES TO THE AUTHORS

Authors must ensure the following requirements are fulfilled at the time of submitting the research paper:

- All Accepted papers will be published in Peer Reviewed Refereed & UGC Listed Journal No. 40776 "AJANTA" ISSN 2277-5730 with Impact Factor 8.172.

- Single or Double-Blind Peer Review

- Full paper must be written in English, Marathi and Hindi as a Microsoft Word format.

- Full paper should be in Times New Roman for English or APS-DV-Priyanka, DVBW TTSurekh (ISM V6), Unicode, Mangal, Kokila for Marathi or Hindi.

- Font Size 12 and line spacing should be 1.5, Footnotes: size 10 in APA style

- Word limit of the article should be 1500 to 2000 (5-6 pages) maximum including abstract

The manuscript must be original and should not have been published earlier in any form.

- The paper must be submitted exclusively for publication in the conference authors.

- Main manuscript: It should contain the abstract, keywords, main text and references.

- Title pages: It should include the title of the paper, names of the authors, mobile number and the email id of the corresponding author/s.

- Reference should be given at the end of the paper in APA style. For website references, the entire URL should be provided. Soft copy of the research paper should be sent by email only to : bctcl.research@gmail.com

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
