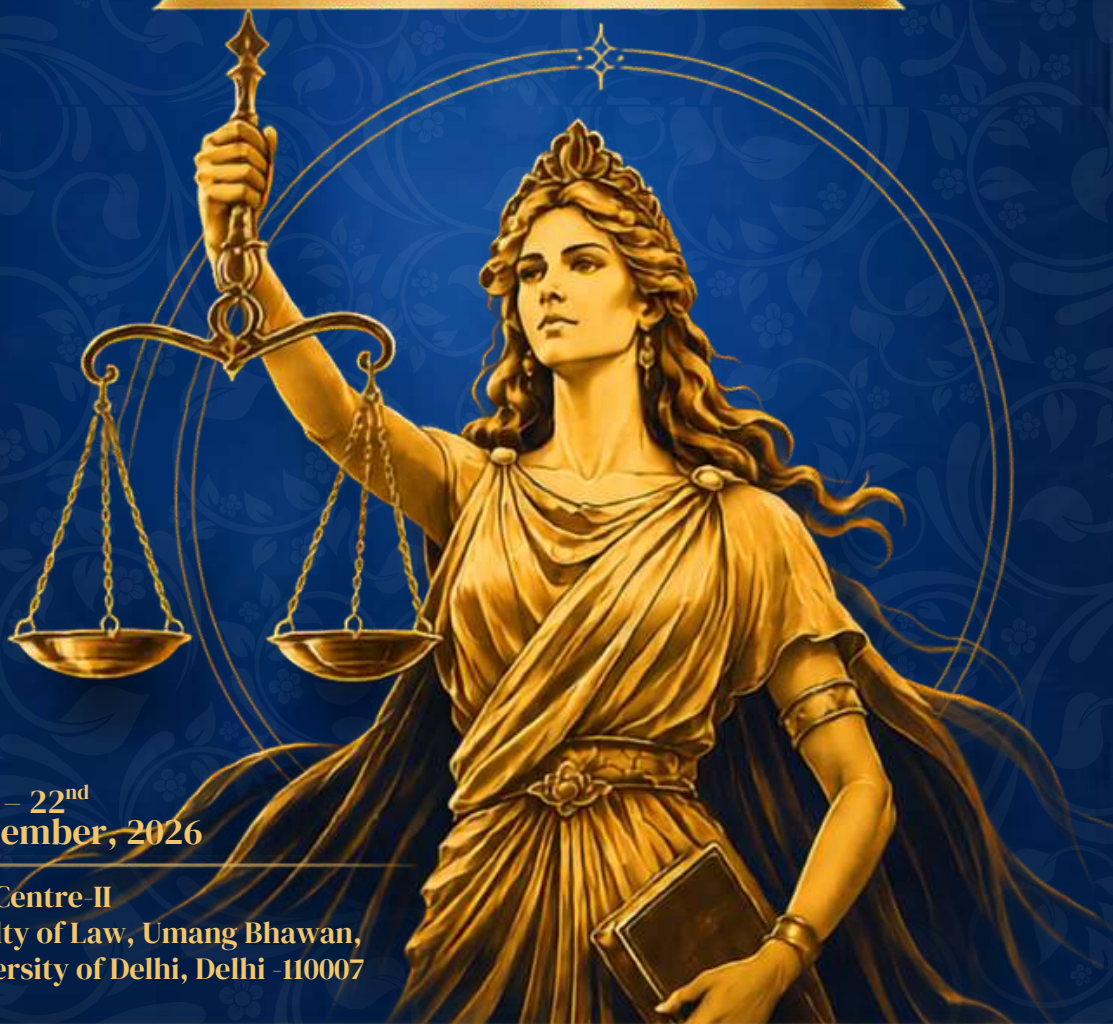

ABOUT FACULTY OF LAW UNIVERSITY OF DELHI

The University of Delhi is a Central University functioning under the **Act of Parliament**. It is recognized as an institution of national importance by the **Constitution of India** (*Seventh Schedule, List-I, Entry-63*). It was established in **1922**.

The Faculty of Law was established in **1924** by the University of Delhi and is accredited by the **Bar Council of India** for its LL.B. degree.

The Faculty of Law was initially located in the **Prince's Pavilion** in the Old Vice Regal Lodge Grounds, where presently the Anthropology Department is housed. In **1963**, it was moved to its present location on **Chhatra Marg, North Campus, University of Delhi**. The Faculty of Law held all morning and evening classes for LL.B., LL.M., and M.C.L. in the Faculty of Law building on Chhatra Marg before **1970**.

The Faculty of Law, University of Delhi was the pioneer in adopting and propagating the use of the **Case Method** as the primary mode of teaching supplemented with the lecture method. The other reading materials are also provided by the teacher concerned. The library of the Faculty of Law was established in **July 1924**. It is one of the best law libraries in the country. It has over **one lakh fifty thousand books and a large number of law reports and journals**. It subscribes to nearly **140 national and international journals**. The library caters to the needs of students and researchers engaged in legal studies, besides catering to the needs of the Bench and the Bar.



ABOUT LAW CENTRE - II



Law Centre - II has had a glorious past of **55 years**. The Centre had the privilege of being headed by the top law scholars of India, such as **Prof. (Dr.) Upendra Baxi**, a well-known jurist and former Vice- Chancellor of the University of Delhi; **Prof. (Dr.) Tahir Mahmood**, who subsequently became Chairperson, Minority Commission; **Prof. (Dr.) A.K. Koul**, who was elevated as Vice-Chancellor, National Law University Jodhpur and National University of Study and Research in Law, Ranchi; **Prof. (Dr.) Gurdip Singh**, who became Vice- Chancellor, Ram Manohar Lohia National Law University, Lucknow; **Prof. (Dr.) B.T. Kaul**, who became Chairperson, Delhi Judicial Academy; **Prof. (Dr.) Poonam Saxena**, who is former Vice- Chancellor, National Law University, Jodhpur, and **Prof. (Dr.) V.K. Ahuja**, who is the former Vice-Chancellor of the National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam, and currently serves as the Director of the Indian Law Institute.

To promote faculty and student activities at the Centre, a number of committees have been constituted. These committees include **Moot Court Society (MCS)**, **Debate and Discussion Society (DDS)**, **Seminars, Conferences and Extension Lectures**, **Journal Committee**, **Legal Aid Committee**, **Placement Committee**, **Alumni Committee**, **Anti-ragging Committee**, **Gender Sensitisation Committee** and many more. There is active participation of students in these Committees. The teacher members and student volunteers organize several activities on a regular basis throughout the year. **The Legal Aid Committee** organizes legal aid camps and helps a substantial number of students to work as **Para Legal Volunteers (PLVs)**. **The Internship and Placement Committee** is responsible for the internship of students and placement of final year students.

The S.K. Puri Memorial Moot Court Competition of Law Centre - II "**JUSTIFIED**" is an annual activity in which teams from various parts of the country and the world participate.



ABOUT LATE SHRI S.K. PURI



SHRI S.K. PURI

Shri Surinder Kumar Puri was born in 1937 in Punjab, where his family lost everything during the partition of the country. With sheer grit and determination, Shri S.K. Puri persevered against the odds to obtain his law degree from the **University of Delhi** in **1962**. Shri S.K. Puri learned under the mentorship of the best legal minds. He began his practice under the mentorship of **Shri Bawa Shiv Charan**, an authority on criminal and civil law in the **Tis Hazari Court of Delhi**.

His father-in-law, **Late Shri F.C. Bedi**, was the doyen of Asia's largest bar, i.e., Delhi Bar Association, and also served as its President. Vakil Lane, a street near KG Marg in New Delhi, has been named after him.

Being a **first-generation lawyer**, Shri S.K. Puri had humble beginnings from a small wooden bench under a tree in the Tis Hazari Court. In 1968, he grew his practice to the Delhi High Court and rose to become a successful lawyer, who was designated as a celebrated Senior Advocate in 2001 by the Delhi High Court.

Apart from being a consummate lawyer, Shri S.K. Puri was endowed with great leadership qualities. He served as the **Joint Secretary** of the **Delhi Bar Association (DBA)** and was also elected as the **Honorary Secretary** of the **Delhi High Court Bar Association (DHCBA)** for **six terms**, between **1974** and **1985**. He had a reputation as an upright, ethical, and honest lawyer among his peers, and during his time in office, he fought for the rights of lawyers and was instrumental in getting the first Chamber Block constructed in the High Court of Delhi.



Often referred to as the '*Ready Reckoner*', Shri S.K. Puri was blessed with eidetic memory, which he used to his benefit in court by efficiently recalling details of documents. He freely shared his knowledge with peers and juniors and was appreciated in the community for his sensitivity. He also built a reputation as an incisive cross-examiner who brought the toughest witnesses to their knees. Shri S.K. Puri believed in the '**3P's of practice**—*Preparation, Presence, and Perseverance*. He embodied these qualities to emerge with unparalleled skill and court craft.

Shri S.K. Puri's illustrious legacy has been carried forward on the able shoulders of his sons, **Mr. Gaurav Puri** and **Mr. Sacchin Puri**. **Mr. Gaurav Puri** has been the **Joint Secretary of the Delhi High Court Bar Association for two terms**.

Mr. Sacchin Puri, a legal luminary with a distinguished career spanning decades, is widely recognized for his dedication and legal acumen. As the Managing Partner of **M/s. UCOL Advocates & Consultants**, he has steered the firm to unprecedented success for over a decade. He currently serves as the **Vice President of the Delhi High Court Bar Association (DHCBA)**.

A courtroom maestro, Mr. Sacchin Puri's expertise shines in high-profile civil and criminal litigations, serving a diverse clientele from government bodies to **Fortune 500 companies**. In 2013, he transitioned to practice as an independent counsel, achieving Senior Advocate status in just three years. His influence also guided the growth of **M/s SPLC, Advocates and Consultants**.

For over 10 years, Mr. Sacchin Puri has been a celebrated Senior Advocate, recognized for his exceptional skills by the esteemed Delhi High Court. A **distinguished alumnus of Law Centre-II**, he established a poignant memorial Moot Court Competition, showcasing his commitment to nurturing future legal minds.

MOOTING AT LAW CENTRE-II

Since its inception, Law Centre-II has enthusiastically encouraged robust mooting culture among its students by regularly organizing moot court competitions and debates. Our members get unparalleled learning opportunities through participation in **National and International Moot Court competitions** and **Alternate Dispute Resolution competitions**, along with **trial advocacy, judgment writing, debate, and quiz competitions**. We hold regular webinars with learned guest speakers to help our members and the student community at large hone their mooting skills.

In **2015**, the Moot Court Society of Law Centre-II initiated the institution's very own moot court competition at a national level, called '**Justified**'. The first edition of the competition saw enthusiastic participation from across the country, with major law schools participating through their learned mooters.



The **2nd edition** of Justified was organized in **2017** on a much larger scale. The occasion was graced by **Hon'ble Justice Sangita Dhingra Sehgal** and **Hon'ble Justice (retd.) S.N. Dhingra** of the Delhi High Court as our Chief Guests, while **Mr. G.R. Raghvendra**, the then Joint Secretary at the Department of Justice, was in attendance as the Guest of Honour.

The year **2018** saw a welcome collaboration between the offices of **Mr. Sacchin Puri**, senior advocate, and the Moot Court Society of Law Centre-II, which brought forth **the very first S.K. Puri Memorial International Moot Court Competition Justified 2018**.

Being an alumnus of Law Centre- II, he instituted a memorial Moot Court Competition in memory of his late father to help law students imbibe the qualities espoused by **Shri S.K. Puri** and to enhance their knowledge and skills. The event was organised on a large scale, and the halls of Law Centre-II were decked up to welcome teams from leading law schools of India.

The final rounds were judged by a bench of **Hon'ble Justice Mr. A.K. Pathak** and **Hon'ble Justice Mr. Vibhu Bakhru**, Hon'ble Judges of the Delhi High Court, while **Hon'ble Justice A.K. Sikri** presented the awards during the awards ceremony. **Army Institute, Mohali**, was adjudged as the winning team and was awarded a cash prize of **Rs. 31,000/-** while **UILS from Punjab University** was the Runners-up team and was awarded **Rs. 21,000/-**. Both teams, along with teams of the quarter-final rounds, were also awarded internships.

The final rounds of **JUSTIFIED'19** witnessed stiff competition between **National Law University, Delhi** and **Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law, Mumbai**, which were judged by a Bench comprising **Hon'ble Justice Siddharth Mridul**, Presiding Judge, High Court of Delhi, **Mr. Sanjay Jain**, Additional Solicitor General of India, and **Mr. S.B. Mitra**, ED (HR & Law), GAIL. The team from National Law University, Delhi was adjudged as the winning team and Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law, Mumbai bagged the Runners-Up position.
