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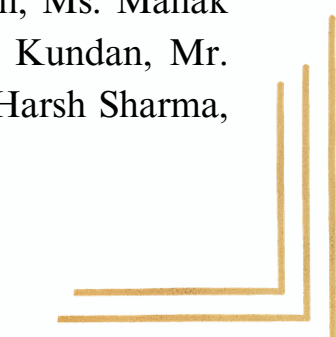

CALL FOR PAPERS

Authors from around the globe are invited to submit their original and unpublished research papers and join us for an offline, on-campus conference at The ICFAI University, Jaipur, on 20–21 November, 2026.

NOTE: The above key themes are only suggestive but not exhaustive. The participants may submit their research papers within the broad areas of the key themes of the conference.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- **Language:** All submissions must be in English language.
- **Word Limit:** The abstract should be between 250-300 words along with 5-7 keywords. The full research paper should be between 4000-5000 words, inclusive of all citation, references, and footnotes.
- **Font and Line Spacing:** Submissions must be typed in Times New Roman, Font Size 12 on A4 size paper with 1-inch margin on all sides with 1.5-line spacing. Potential contributors are required to adhere to a uniform mode of citation style, namely the 20th Edition of The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation. The submission must be made in MS Word format.
- **Plagiarism Policy:** All submissions must be original and unpublished work. The similarity index of the full paper should not exceed 10%, excluding properly cited quotations, references, and bibliographical material. Submissions found to be plagiarised or containing significant unattributed material shall be rejected. The decision of the Conference Organising Committee in this regard shall be final.
- **Registration:** Submission of the abstract will be considered as a provisional registration and the name of co-authors are also required to mentioned in the abstract submission form.
- **Abstract Submission:** Abstract of the paper should be submitted through google form on or before 21st October, 2026 at 11:59 P.M. IST through the link mentioned below.

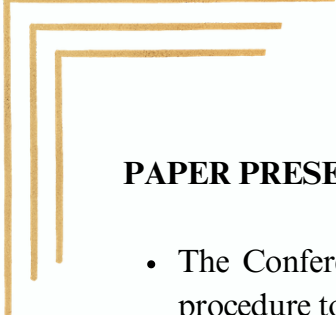

- **Submission of Full Paper:** Upon acceptance of the abstract, the full paper has to be submitted via google form link on or before 04th November, 2026 at 11:59 P.M. IST. The google form link for full paper submission will be sent with the mail of acceptance.
- **Hard Copy:** A hard copy of the full paper and abstract must be brought on the day of conference.
- **Review and Acceptance:** All abstracts and full papers shall be subject to a review process. The decision regarding the acceptance or rejection of the submission shall be communicated to the respective authors. The decision of the Conference Organising Committee shall be final.

PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITY

- Selected full papers, subject to the recommendations of the review committee and compliance with the publication guidelines, may be considered for publication in an edited book, conference proceedings, or other appropriate publication platforms. Further details regarding publication shall be communicated separately.
- The Conference Organising Committee reserves the right to make necessary editorial modifications, including corrections in language, formatting, style, and citation, to the selected papers before publication. Any substantial changes to the content of the paper shall be made in consultation with the author(s), wherever required.



PAPER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- The Conference shall have paper presentations that shall be selected after a blind peer review procedure to be conducted by the review board.
- The presenters will present their papers before a panel of experts who shall adjudge the paper presentations.
- At least one author of each accepted paper must register for and present the paper at the conference. A certificate of presentation shall be issued to the registered participants as per the conference norms.
- In case of co-authorship at least one author must attend the conference to present the paper.
- The participants may adopt any suitable means for presenting the papers including Audio-Visual aids, Power Point Presentations etc.

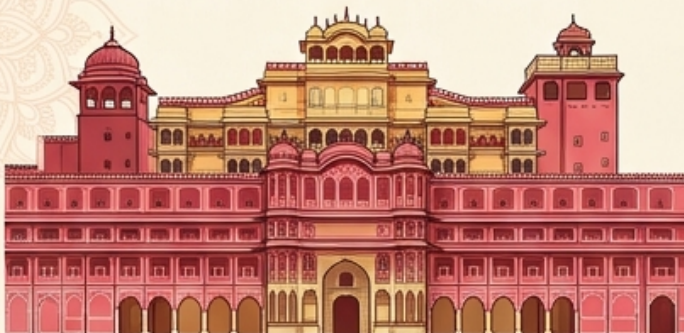
