- The seminar is intended to promote academic dialogue and legal insight. Personal or political agendas will not be entertained.
- The dates for registration and paper submission are subject to possible extension, which will be duly notified.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Participants must maintain professional behaviour throughout the event. – Any kind of offensive language or personal attacks will result in immediate removal from the event.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The Competition is open for students pursuing three/five-year LL.B. Degree Courses from recognized Law Colleges/Universities in India, subject to fulfilment of the registration formalities.
- The team members shall be students of the same institution.
- There shall be TWO TEAMS from a Law School / Law College.
- Participation in the Seminar and Online Policy Drafting is open to all.
- Each team shall be assigned a team code. Teams shall use only their team code for identification purposes during the competition.
- Registration for each event will be a separate submission.

LANGUAGE

- All oral and written submissions are required to be made in English.
- It shall also be the official language of the Competition.

TEAM COMPOSITION

1. Each team shall consist of 3 members (2 speakers and 1 researcher).
2. Each team will have a team code. Teams should not disclose their identity or that of their institution or city, etc.; such disclosure shall invite penalties, including disqualification, though the advocates may disclose their names while addressing the court. The decision for the same shall be at the discretion of the Organiser.

*Each college or university is allowed to send two teams comprising two speakers and one researcher. *

ELIGIBILITY

Students pursuing three- or five year courses of LL.B degree in current academic year from any recognized law school/ college/ university in India are eligible to participate for the purpose.

RESEARCHER'S TEST:

- Oral and Written Test will be conducted on 31st Oct, 2026.
