HSNC BOARD

Hyderabad (Sind) National Collegiate Board (popularly known as HSNC Board) has been a pioneer in the field of higher education and was managing the National College in Hyderabad (Sind) for long time before the partition of India. The Board was associated with the national movement for the Independence of India. After the partition of the country in 1947, the Hindus were compelled to abandon the place and migrate to India. Late Principal K.M. Kundnani was the Principal of the college at that time. After the partition, Principal Kundnani appreciated the need of his teaching fraternity and the community and initiated efforts for starting a college in Mumbai. He received active support and encouragement from Barrister Hotchand Gopaldas Advani. Both of them together founded the Hyderabad (Sind) National Collegiate Board in 1949, at Mumbai. Barrister H.G. Advani was the Founder President and Principal K. M. Kundnani, was the Founder Secretary and Principal of the first college started by the Board. This was followed by a chain of educational institutions belonging to various faculties such as Arts, Commerce, Science, Education, Law, Engineering, Technology, Paramedical and Management.

The Mission of the Board is to strive for excellence in academics, innovation in education, research, cultural, sports and other extracurricular activities. The Vision of HSNC Board is to provide 'WORLD CLASS EDUCATION, COMPARABLE TO THE BEST OF THE INSTITUTIONS IN INDIA AND ABROAD'. In the Year 2019 HSNC Board constituted a state cluster University named HSNC University, Mumbai. It is the first private state cluster University in Maharashtra.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF RESEARCH PAPERS

- **CALL FOR PAPERS:** The organizers invite original, unpublished research papers for this Countrywide conference on the theme of the conference.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** All Stream Students and Research Scholars.
- The Research Paper has to be in the English Language only. The front page of the Research Paper shall include the Title of the Research Paper, Name of the Author, Class, Name of the College, Email-id and Mobile Number.
- The paper should be a 'Word File', having 'Times New Roman' as Font. The Font Size should be 14" for Titles, 12' for sub-titles, 10" for Body Text and Footnotes and a margin of 1.5 inch on the left and 1 inch on the right and line spacing of 1.5 inch.
- The Full paper should not exceed 3500 words and may contain Introduction, Objectives, Statement of the Problem, Hypothesis, Methodology, Suggestion, Conclusions and References.
- The paper shall be written by a single author or along with one co-author.
- References should be given at the end of the paper and should be as per the APA style. In case of website references, the entire URL should be provided.
- Each paper presenter or participant must register on the provided Registration Form Link individually in order to participate in the Conference.
- Soft copy of research paper in word file should be sent to email id: countrywideconference.2026@gmail.com along with plagiarism report (less than 10%) on/before 10th October 2026.
- Individual registration is compulsory for both the authors if the paper is co-authored.
- Registration fee of Rs. 500/- for each Author & Co-Author individually, Rs. 300/- for each participant to be made on the Payment Link and the screenshot of the payment must be uploaded in the Registration Form link provided.

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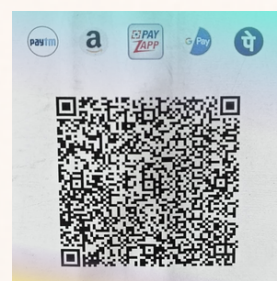
